Place of incident	Gulburg Society and the surrounding areas were the first places to be attacked
Major crimes/incidents	-The incident near the Gulburg society and the surrounding area lead to dead of 69 people. -Various shops and houses were looted. The area surroundings were burned down. - The entire Gulburg society was demolished and the people living there suffered severe loss of property.

Details of the investigation	The FIR was filed at 28.02.2002
Charge sheets	A total of 9 chargesheets were filed in this case out of which -All 9 chargesheets were produced in the lower courts -however 3 chargesheets were considered to be defective (Firstly three chargesheets produced but defective and then challenge in SC)
Arrested accused	A total of 67 accused were arrested. Out of which 3 accused i.e. Accused no.6,7,,20 died before trial and another 6 accused died during the trial. Another 2 accused were added in u/s 319 of CrPc application.
