Will the Minister of Border Areas Development be pleased to state:

- (a) What are the programmes taken by the Govt. for the development of Indo-Bangladesh Border Areas ?
- (b) Does the Government feel satisfied with whatever activities already taken by now ?
- (c) When will the fencing be completed in disputed and riverine areas ?
- (d) What has the Govt. to say about Roads and link Roads (border) and communications (including tele and digital) and Lighting arrangement ?
- (e) There is scarcity of fresh and pure drinking water in the border-areas. Will the department provide adequate drinking water ?

**ANSWER**

Shri Chandra Mohan Patowary, Hon'ble Minister, Commerce & Industry, Transport and Parliamentary Affairs, Assam, will reply on behalf of Hon'ble Minister, Border Protection and Development Department, Assam :

- (a) Various development schemes under Border Areas Development programme (BADP-SCA) are taken by Govt. for development of Indo-Bangladesh Border Areas.
- (b) Yes. Schemes are implemented satisfactorily.
- (c) Work of a stretch of 4.35 km at Karimganj, is held up due to BGB objection based on need for erection of reference pillars in that area. The matter has been taken up by Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), New Delhi with the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA) for an early solution of the problem.

The riverine stretch of 48.11 km is proposed to be plugged by means of non-physical barrier i.e. Technological solution. The work is in progress under BSF. Target date of completion is September, 2018.

- (d) Border roads are available all along the border and being maintained by CPWD. The maintenance is being done on requirement basis by CPWD. The District administration has constructed link roads which are also being maintained/repared by District administration. Development of road network in border areas is given priority under BADP.

BOPs are connected with telecommunication and mobile network.

All BSF Bn. HQ/BOPs are having electricity connectivity and Gen sets have also been provided for backup arrangement. The Border Flood Lights (BFLs) are functioning through DG sets for which sufficient POL is made available. Moreover, dedicated power supply to BFLs has been taken up by CPWD/APDCL of which Dhubri sector has been completed and Karimganj sector is under progress. Low voltage problem in Dhubri - South Salmara sector is also being addressed through additional sub-station.

- (e) As per decision taken in the State Level Screening Committee (SLSC) meeting held on 15/7/2016, it was resolved that the first and foremost development priority will be given for good road connectivity through respective line departments. Other sectors like health, education etc. will be taken up in these areas. However, in the instance of extreme drinking water scarcity, proposals for drinking water facilities can be placed before the SLSC for consideration of such proposal.

**OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

Sub : Terms & condition for appointment of Judicial Officer as Member, Foreigners Tribunals, Assam.

Ministry of Home affairs Government of India has issued new terms and condition for appointment of Members in the Foreigners Tribunals vide letter No. 11012/48/2005-NE-IV dated 24-01-2011. Considering the current problem faced due to dearth of eligible Judicial Officers, Government of India have set this new terms and conditions which are as follows:

1. An officer will have to be serving/retired District and Sessions Judge or Additional District Judge.
2. Maximum age up to which the officer will be allowed to work is 67 years.
3. The initial period of appointment shall be for one year which may extend if necessary subject to the maximum age fixed at 67 years.

**Pay and allowance of the Members will be regulated as noted below:**

(a) For serving Judicial Officers:

Pay & allowances as admissible in his/her Grade as recommended by the competent authority applicable to State Judicial Officers.

In addition a deputation allowance @ 15% of his pay subject to maximum Rs. 2000/- P.M. plus a special duty allowance @ 12.5% of the basic pay.

(b) For re-employed (retired) Judicial Officers:

Last pay drawn or Minimum pay in the revised scale corresponding to the post held at the time of superannuation which ever is higher minus pension plus Dearness Allowances at the rate admissible to State Govt. employees.

In addition, special pay @ 15% of his pay subject to a maximum Rs. 2000/- plus a special duty allowance @ 12.5% of the basic pay.

4. **Medical Facilities:**

Medical facilities will be provided to Member, Foreigners Tribunal (both in-service and retired) as per Judicial Department's Notification No. JDJ(E)-44/2002/Pt/34 Dated 7<sup>th</sup> March 2007 read with Assam Medical Attendance Rules, 2008 and Notification issued there under from time to time.

5. **Conveyance:**

A car along with staff car driver will be provided for each member of Foreigners Tribunal who will be entitled to 60 (sixty) liters P.O.L. per month.

6. **Transfer grants:**

Member Foreigners Tribunals are entitled to transfer grants as admissible to Judicial Officers of relevant rank.

7. One Orderly Peon will be admissible to each Member, Foreigner's Tribunal with a fixed remuneration of Rs. 4500/- per month except in respect of those Foreigner's Tribunals where Orderly Peon with Grade Pay have already been appointed. The tenure of engagement of Orderly Peon shall be co-terminus with the tenure of the Members.

8. **House Rent allowance:**

- (a) For serving Judicial Officers:

HRA as admissible in his/her Grade as recommended by the competent authority applicable to the State Judicial Officers.

- (b) For re-employed (retired) Judicial Officers:


Rs. 4000/- P.M. fixed.

9. **Traveling Allowance/Transfer T.A.**

As per State Government Rules as admissible to Judicial Officers including transportation of personal effects as admissible to State Government. However, officers will be eligible for Air Travel on duty for journeys within and outside the State.

10. As admissible to the in serving Judicial Officers of Assam. A Member may avail of home LTC once in a block period of two years. A Member may avail LTC once in four years as admissible to Member of the corresponding ranks in Assam Judicial Service and this facility will be restricted to his/her spouse and dependent children.

11. For all other purpose the in service officers service as Member Foreigners Tribunal shall be governed by the respective rules, notification, order etc. as admissible to Judicial Officers. The retired Judicial Officers serving as Member Foreigners Tribunal shall be governed by the term and conditions as spelt out above.



**Sub. : Terms & Condition for appointment of Advocates as Member, Foreigners Tribunal, Assam.**

Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India has issued new terms and condition for appointment of Advocate as Member, Foreigners Tribunal in Assam vide their letter No. 11012/48/2005-NE-IV dated 26/12/2014 considering the Hon'ble Gauhati High Court Judgment & Order in W.P.(C) No. 3282/2014 Ashim Roy -Vs- State of Assam & Ors. and the current problem faced due to dearth of eligible Judicial Officers, Government of India have set this new terms and condition which are as follows :-

1. An Advocate with the minimum age of 45 (forty five) years and 10 years of Legal Experience / Legal Practice will be considered for appointment as Member, Foreigners Tribunal for additional 64 (sixty four) nos. of Foreigners Tribunals in Assam initially for 2 (two) years in addition to sitting / retired District Judge / Additional District Judge.
2. Maximum age upto which Advocates will be allowed to work is 60 (sixty) years. Extension of tenure may be considered upto 1 (one) year on need basis.
3. In so far as existing 36 (thirty six) Foreigners Tribunals are concerned, Advocates may be appointed as per above prescribed norms.
4. Appointment of Advocates as Member, Foreigners Tribunal will be purely on contractual basis with fixed pay of Rs.85,000/- (Rupees eighty five thousand) per month, initially for 2 (two) years on as extended from time to time on need basis.
5. The Member shall be eligible for 12 (twelve) days special leave in a year as per State Government Rule. They will also avail earned leave as admissible as per Leave Rule 1934 (as amended).
6. A car alongwith Driver or monthly fixed conveyance allowance @ 5,000/- per month will be provided to the each Member.
7. The selection of the Advocate as member, Foreigners Tribunal will be done by a 3 (three) Members Special Bench of Gauhati High Court which is constituted by the Chief Justice of Gauhati High Court as per direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P.(C) No.562/2012 and the process of selection of Member, Foreigners Tribunal, will be done if required in phases, depending on the availability of officers opting to serve in the Tribunals.
8. For all other purpose the Advocate serving as Member, Foreigners Tribunal in Assam shall be governed by the terms and conditions as spelt out above on condition that no other facilities are borne from the State Exchequer which are non reimbursable from the Government of India.
