Govt designates Tribal Affairs Department as Nodal Agency for FRA implementation Tribal Affairs Minister hails decision as landmark step JAMMU, DECEMBER 12: Tribal Affairs Minister, Javed Ahmed Rana, today hailed the government's decision to designate the Tribal Affairs Department as the Nodal Department for implementation of the Forest Rights Act (FRA), 2006 across Jammu & Kashmir. Describing the move as a historic and corrective intervention, the Minister emphasized that this is a landmark step, reflecting the long-standing aspirations of tribal communities. This will ensure a more community-centric, accessible and responsive institutional mechanism for implementation of FRA, he added.
