

## **MAPPING A PARALLEL SOVEREIGNTY: DOCUMENTATION OF AHP–RBD MOBILISATION**

### **(six-month dataset)**

This document accompanies the main analytical article and serves as an evidentiary and descriptive record of the six-month mobilisation undertaken by the Antarrashtriya Hindu Parishad (AHP) and its affiliate, the Rashtriya Bajrang Dal (RBD), across multiple Indian states. It compiles documented instances of public meetings, rallies, weapon worship ceremonies, training camps, protests, and targeted interventions into community life, drawing primarily from verified video records, media reports, and publicly available documentation. The dataset spans a wide geographical range and captures both urban and rural mobilisations, reflecting the breadth and intensity of AHP–RBD’s organisational activity during the period under study.

Rather than treating each incident as an isolated episode, this document presents them as part of a sustained and patterned mobilisation strategy. The entries reveal recurring themes: the ritualisation of weapons and violence; the construction of Muslims and Christians as internal enemies; the regulation of gender, sexuality, and interfaith relationships; demographic fear-mongering; economic boycotts; and the assertion of extra-legal authority over religious practice, public space, and everyday social relations. Repeated across locations and time, these actions demonstrate organisational continuity, ideological coherence, and an effort to normalise vigilantism as a legitimate mode of civic engagement.

Of particular socio-legal significance is the recurrent presence or acquiescence of state authorities—especially the police—at events featuring inflammatory speeches, weapon displays, and calls for violence or social exclusion. Several entries document instances where AHP–RBD actors appear to exercise coercive power alongside or in place of formal legal authority, including raids, public “inspections,” moral policing, and the disruption of minority religious gatherings. These interactions underscore how vigilante mobilisation is enabled not only by ideological mobilisation but also by institutional abdication and selective enforcement of law.

This dataset is therefore not merely a listicle of hate incidents. It constitutes an empirical map of an emerging parallel moral and political order—one that operates within the shell of constitutional democracy while actively undermining its principles. Read alongside the main article, this document provides the granular empirical foundation for understanding how organised hate functions as infrastructure: replicable, routinised, and embedded in everyday public life. It is intended to support legal analysis, policy intervention, and scholarly inquiry into the transformation of communal mobilisation from sporadic violence into a sustained mode of governance.

He also called for an economic boycott of Muslims and of tourism in Kashmir.

Rajni Thakural, president of AHP-Ojaswini, while speaking at a Ram Katha event, promoted their weekly Hanuman Chalisa centres by targeting Muslims and Christians. He linked Islam to historical violence, claiming Muslims have been killing Hindus since 1200 BC and citing "la ilaha illallah" from the Quran as justification. At a training camp organised by the AHP-Rashtriya Bajrang Dal, National President Manoj Kumar claimed that Hindus do not need Muslim male friends but need Muslim women to marry. He went on to say that Muslims attempting to marry Hindu girls should be killed. He falsely claimed that Muslim women wish to marry into Hindu families and have Hindu children, adding that it is time to marry them. He further declared that India belongs only to Hindus and called for an economic boycott of Muslims.
