

## **A year of reported violence and discrimination against Christians in India**

Across 2025, incidents of violence, intimidation, administrative obstruction, and legal harassment targeting Christians were reported from multiple states across India. These were not confined to a single region, nor limited to one form of hostility. Prayer meetings were raided, pastors arrested under anti-conversion laws, burial rights denied, churches vandalised, and Christian families threatened with social boycott or displacement. The pattern that emerges from these reports is not one of sporadic communal flare-ups, but of sustained and geographically dispersed targeting.

What is striking is the repetition of method. In state after state, similar sequences unfolded: local vigilante groups alleged forced conversions, police intervened—often against the Christian worshippers rather than the complainants—and cases were registered under anti-conversion statutes or public order provisions. Even where no evidence of coercion was found, arrests, detention, and social stigma followed. In several instances, the mere act of gathering for prayer became grounds for suspicion and state action.

The following list documents reported incidents throughout the year. Read individually, each case may appear localised. Taken together, however, they reveal a broader climate in which Christian identity was increasingly treated as suspect, conditional, and vulnerable to both private aggression and institutional complicity. This compilation records not only acts of violence, but the gradual normalisation of exclusion.

### **Incidents from January 2025 to December 2025**

Location: Bhiwani, Haryana

Date: January 2

Mahant Shukrai Nath Yogi, while campaigning against Christian missionaries, urged people to report them directly to him, if not the police. He claimed he had started wearing shoes specifically to confront them, stating that they won't understand without the usage of shoes. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1194>

Location: Porbandar, Gujarat

Members of the Vishwa Hindu Parishad and Bajrang Dal patrolled the city of Porbandar, Gujarat, intimidating shopkeepers and issuing threats against selling Santa Claus and Christmas-related items. Under pressure and fearing repercussions, shopkeepers apologized and pledged to stop selling Christmas memorabilia. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1203>

Location: Rohtak, Haryana

Date: January 5

Multiple Hindu nationalist organizations staged a protest outside a church, reciting the Hanuman Chalisa in a clear act of intimidation. Police were deployed at the site to safeguard Christian worshippers and ensure their safety amid the heightened tension. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1224>

Location: Solan, Himachal Pradesh

Date: January 10

At a Trishul Deeksha event by VHP-Bajrang Dal, several religious preachers delivered speeches targeting Muslims and Christians. The speakers urged Hindus to take up arms against Muslims, spreading fear about religious conversions to Islam and Christianity while also targeting Christian missionary schools. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1245>

Location: Karda, Jalore, Rajasthan

Date: January 12

At the Sanchalan event, speakers from the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh spread fear about Christian conversions, alleging a rapid proliferation of churches and missionary activities in the Northeast that incite communal tensions. They propagated concerns about a supposed Hindu exodus from Kerala and hinted at a Muslim majority causing the displacement of Hindus in West Bengal, Kerala, and Kashmir. The speakers also fear-mongered about Bangladeshi infiltration, alleging their involvement in "anti-national activities," and warned about the rise of "intellectual terrorism."

Date: January 17

Bajrang Dal members, led by Rishi Shukla, raided a Christian prayer meeting held at a household. They harassed the attendees, accused them of engaging in religious conversions, and called the police. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1272>

Date: January 16

At the Virat Hindu Jagran Sabha, Hindu Rashtra Sena Founder and National President Dhananjay Desai propagated Savarkar's theory on Indian identity, stating, "People whose holy places are in Arabia and the Vatican are not true Indians." He spread the baseless conspiracy of 'love jihad', demonized Muslims as traitors, and warned about alleged Christian conversions in North-East India. Desai also raised alarm about supposed Bangladeshi infiltration in Maharashtra and Karnataka and claimed Muslims are conspiring to Islamize India. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1290>

Date: January 22

Members of Bajrang Dal held a campaign against Christian missionaries, accusing them of converting people by offering jobs, employment and financial support for marriages. Date: January 11

At a VHP-Bajrang Dal event marking the first anniversary of the Ram Mandir, a speaker peddled the conspiracy theory of "love jihad" and accused Christian missionaries of converting people to break the Hindu society. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1414>

Date: January 27

Members of Bajrang Dal, along with the police, raided a Christian family's house accusing them of engaging in religious conversion. They presented the Bibles in the house as evidence and arrested the couple. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1335>

Location: Behjam, Lakhimpur Kheri, Uttar Pradesh

Date: January 26

The police raided a Christian Sunday prayer meeting and arrested the pastors following allegations by VHP members that they were engaging in religious conversions by luring Hindus with financial incentives. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1340>

Location: Siraha, Madhesh Province, Nepal

Date: January 25

At a meeting organised by Hindu Samrat Sena, a speaker targeted Christians, accusing them of bribing politicians to build churches in the villages, luring Hindu women, and promising to cure health issues. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1352>

Location: Jhabua, Madhya Pradesh

Date: January 23

During a religious sermon at an event organized by the Vishwa Hindu Parishad and Bajrang Dal, a Bajrang Dal leader demonized Christians and Muslims, alleging religious conversions by Christian missionaries and threats posed by the Waqf Board. He declared, "Our Sanatan Dharma is in danger, be it from Mohammedans, Muslims, or Christians," while calling for a halt to conversions. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1353>

Location: Surat, Gujarat

Date: February 3

VHP-Bajrang Dal members, led by Jay Patel Nagraj, harassed Christian pastors for holding a prayer gathering in the locality, accusing them of luring people into conversion. He threatened them not to return, declaring that they believe "not just in Gandhi, but in Godse too" and know how to deal with the English. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1387>

Location: Kokawad, Jhabua, Madhya Pradesh

Date: January 29

At the Death Anniversary of Sant Shri Khoom Singh Ji Maharaj, Bajrang Dal leader Azad Prem Singh delivered an anti-Christian hate speech, threatening violence against those involved in religious conversions. He stated, “These conversions are a trick plotted by vidharmis. Don’t worry, I know how to ‘fix them.’ I know how to use a stick and weapons as well.”

Singh also boasted about shutting down seven churches and ensuring jail terms and fines for seventy priests. He warned of stricter action against churches in the future. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1494>

Date: February 3

Rashtriya Bajrang Dal members held Saraswati Puja at the gate of a Christian missionary school by placing an idol and holding rituals. They had earlier asked the school to conduct the puja inside the school premises, claiming the principal had agreed but later refused. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1389>

Location: Surat, Gujarat

Date: February 1

Hindu nationalists, led by Narendra Choudhary, forced out a group of Christian individuals who had come to collect a man's body for burial. The Christian group claimed that the man was Christian and the family called them. Date: February 2

Bajrang Dal staged a protest outside a school over a plaque outside a classroom displaying a quote from Jesus Christ. Location: Kurukshetra, Haryana

Date : February 1

At a Pooja event organized by Arya Samaj, Supreme Court lawyer-activist Ashwini Upadhyay and an Arya Samaj far-right monk delivered speeches demonizing Muslims and Christians. Upadhyay spread the conspiracies of 'love jihad,' 'drug jihad,' 'infiltrator jihad,' 'religious conversion jihad,' and 'population jihad.' He also demanded the shutdown of madrasas and missionary schools and called for strict laws against 'love jihad' and 'land jihad.' The Arya Samaj monk instilled fear by warning of another partition in India and demonized Christianity and Islam, calling them 'foreign problems.' <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1424>

Date: February 9

Members of the Akhil Bharatiya Hindu Mahasabha attempted to raid a Christian Sunday prayer meeting held in a church at a residence, accusing the attendees of religious conversion. Date: February 8

Police arrested M.K. Thomas, C.C. Thomas, and an Adivasi man for allegedly converting Hindus to Christianity after VHP and Bajrang Dal raided their home. Date: February 8

At Trishul Deeksha, organized by Vishwa Hindu Parishad and Bajrang Dal, Advocate Anmol Andare spread the conspiracy of 'love jihad' and encouraged cow vigilantism, escalating religious tensions. Date: February 9

Members of Bajrang Dal raided a Christian prayer meeting, alleging forced religious conversions and demanding it be stopped. The attendees pushed back, questioning their authority. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1444>

Location: Gomti Nagar, Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh

Date: February 9

A far-right mob disrupted Sunday Christian prayers and raised incendiary slogans, escalating communal tension between Hindus and Christians. Location: Shivaji High School, Navapur, Nandurbar, Maharashtra

Date: February 12

At a public event, Arya Samaj speaker Gautam Khattar claimed that “our Sanatan Dharma is threatened by Islam and Christianity,” portraying religious minorities as a danger to Hinduism. Later, he promoted a social and economic boycott of non-Hindus, urging, “Sanatanis should only buy goods and interact with other Sanatanis.” Khattar escalated his rhetoric by leading an oath against missionary schools and using derogatory terms like “Chaddar & Father” to refer to Muslims and Christians. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1460>

Location: Bikaner, Rajasthan

Date: February 16

Members of Bajrang Dal and Hindu Jagran Manch raided a Christian prayer meeting at a private residence, assaulting attendees and vandalising the property while accusing them of indulging in religious conversion. During the attack, they chanted slogans of “Jai Shree Ram” and “Narendra Modi Zindabad” as part of their protest. The police detained 6-7 individuals on accusations of religious conversion.

Date: February 19

At a Shiv Jayanti event, far-right influencer Kajal Hindustani promoted the “rice bag Christian” trope, targeted Muslims, and spread the conspiracy of ‘love jihad.’ She later reinforced this claim, calling Muslims “jihadis” while attacking the azaan. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1516>

Location: Hargaon, Sitapur, Uttar Pradesh

Date: February 23

Bajrang Dal members raided a Christian Sunday prayer meeting, alleging forced religious conversions. Acting on their complaint, the police took more than a dozen people into custody. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1518>

Location: Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh

Date: January 26

Cow vigilante Aadesh Soni, speaking at a Param Dharm Sansad organised by Avimukteshwaranand Saraswati, called for “teaching a lesson” to alleged cow smugglers by breaking their limbs to instill a fear of death. He also announced plans to march to three Christian villages on March 1, accompanied by 5,000 cow vigilantes. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1520>

Date: February 23

Bajrang Dal members detained and assaulted a pastor, accusing him of engaging in “anti-national” activities by converting people to Christianity. They seized copies of the Bible as supposed proof of conversion. Location: Maharishi Vidya Mandir School, Noida, Uttar Pradesh

Date: February 23

During a lecture at Maharishi Vidya Mandir, Sudarshan News editor Suresh Chavhanke criticized teachers for wearing “Isai dress,” claiming it negatively affects children's development. He fearmongered about religious conversions, pushed the “rice bag Christian” trope, and falsely claimed that all Muslims have “four children or more,” at times saying “most have ten to twelve.”

Chavhanke warned that the growing Muslim population would lead to Hindu persecution and falsely claimed that Hindu property values would decline as Muslims increase. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1546>

Date: February 24

A mob attacked the residence of a Christian family, accusing those attending a prayer meeting of carrying out religious conversions. They forcibly removed the covering from a Tulsi shrine and planted a Tulsi tree. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1542>

Location: Jaynagar Majilpur, South 24 Parganas, West Bengal

Date: February 26

Members of the Hindu Jagran Manch harassed four women, accusing them of promoting Christianity and indulging in religious conversions by offering money. They also coerced the women into chanting "Har Har Mahadev."

One of the assailants, claiming to follow Godse instead of Gandhi, issued violent threats and pressured the man to undergo 'ghar wapsi,' referencing choreographer Remo D'Souza's alleged conversion and similar incidents at the Mahakumbh Mela.

Date: February 28

Date: February 28

Madhuram Sharan Shiva, leader of the armed monks' group Shiv Shakti Akhada, targeted Muslims and Christians, comparing them to demons from Hindu mythology. He falsely

claimed there was a conspiracy to eradicate Hinduism and made attendees take oaths to wield weapons. He declared that he respects only Hindus claiming God resides in them, while seeing only demons in those wearing “black clothes.” <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1575>

Hindu nationalists raided a Christian household, conducted searches and showed the Bible as evidence, while accusing the family of engaging in religious conversion. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1581>

At an Arya Samaj event, religious narrator Archana Priya Arya targeted Santa Claus and Christian missionary schools, calling them an "illness." She claimed that while fights occur in missionary schools, they would not happen in schools named after Hindu saints. Date: March 5

At an AHP-Rashtriya Bajrang strategy meeting, speakers targeted Islam and Christianity. Atul Rathore claimed that if Hindus do not resist, they will fall under 'Ghazwa-e-Hind,' but if they fight, they will move toward establishing a 'Hindu Rashtra.' Another leader, Pradeep Gour, claimed that two religions, Islam and Christianity, are responsible for conflicts. At an Adivasi conference, Cabinet Minister and BJP leader Nagarsingh Chouhan targeted Christians, falsely claiming that those converting to Christianity were attempting to create major conflict in society. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1613>

- Location: Sirohi, Madhya Pradesh Date: March 7

Hindu nationalist goons disrupted a prayer meeting, harassed Christians,

and pressured them to leave. They also called the police while intimidating attendees. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1618>

- Location: Vrindavan, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh

Date: March 6

At a religious event, Monk Raju Das fearmongered about the non-Hindu population, spreading conspiracy theories about "love jihad" and religious conversions. He referred to Muslims and Christians as “chadar and father” and raised slogans calling for a “Hindu Rashtra.” <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1627>

Location: Maharajganj, Uttar Pradesh Date: March 9

Bajrang Dal members, accompanied by the police, raided a Christian prayer meeting, accusing the attendees of engaging in religious conversions. They seized bags, purses, and mobile phones, presenting the Bible as evidence of conversion. The police detained several attendees, including the pastor. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1633>

Location: Vrindavan, Mathura, Uttar Pradesh Date: March 8

At a meeting by Rashtriya Bajrang Dal, National President Manoj Kumar declared that the country belongs to Hindus, not Muslims or Christians, asserting that they should live at the mercy of Hindus. He boasted about building the Ram Mandir and stated that their organisation was formed to build temples in Mathura and Kashi. He mentioned conspiracy theories like “love jihad” and “land jihad,” warning of violence against those allegedly involved in them.

Date: March 2

Far-right influencer Kajal Hindustani delivered a hate speech at the Maha Kumbh of Mahila Shakti & Women's Day Celebration, organized by Love for Cow Foundation. She demonized interfaith relationships, referred to Muslims as "jihadis" and "Abduls" and made derogatory remarks about Islam. She also propagated the 'rice bag' trope, claiming that Christians converted for mere sacks of rice, and spread the conspiracies of ‘love jihad’ and ‘land jihad.’ <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1676>

Location: Guna, Madhya Pradesh

Date: March 9

At an official press conference organized by Vishva Hindu Parishad, its Organizing General Secretary, Milind Parande, promoted the conspiracy of 'love jihad,' targeted Christian missionaries, and encouraged people to file legal cases against them. He also declared that Kashi and Mathura would be "freed soon" and asserted that Hindu society would not stop until it was achieved. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1682>

Location: Pathri, Haridwar, Uttarakhand

Date: March 16

Bajrang Dal members, accompanied by the police, raided a Christian Sunday prayer gathering and harassed attendees, accusing them of indulging in illegal religious conversions. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1690>

Location: Jamgaon, Kanker, Chhattisgarh

Date: March 6

At a village meeting, BJP MP Bhojraj Nag targeted non-Hindus in his speech, claiming that those who have converted do not celebrate Hindu festivals and are disrupting communal harmony. He claimed that the Supreme Court has ruled that Christians cannot cremate bodies according to their religious practices in Fifth Schedule areas and urged people to prevent them from doing so. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1693>

Date: March 18

Hindu nationalists, including members of Gau Raksha Dal, assaulted two Christian individuals, accusing them of attempting to forcibly convert a woman. The attackers later handed them over to the police. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1701>

Location: Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh

Date: March 20

Members of Hindu nationalist organisations, led by Thakur Ram Singh and backed by the police, raided a Christian prayer meeting at a conference hall. They alleged that attendees were

being trained to brainwash and convert Hindus. The police arrested three individuals acting on their complaint. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1717>

Location: Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh

Date: March 13

Bajrang Dal and the police stopped the Vidisha-Palakot train, alleging that 12 Hindu men were being converted to Christianity under the guise of drug rehabilitation. Police detained three men and are investigating. The accused denied any forced conversion. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1721>

Location: Gaikwad Mala Road, Nashik, Maharashtra

Date: March 20

A Bajrang Dal worker harassed women attending a Bible study group, accusing them of converting Hindus to Christianity. Despite the women's clarification that they did not force anyone, the accusations led to a heated argument. The women objected to being filmed and walked away. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1723>

Location: WRS Society, Raipur, Chhattisgarh

Date: March 22

Hindu nationalists vandalised and partially demolished a building used as a prayer hall by the Christian community. Local residents have alleged that the attack was carried out by members of the BJP and Bajrang Dal, led by BJP councillor Khagpati Soni. Earlier in the day, railway officials had declared the additional construction in the building illegal. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1739>

Date: March 23

Location: Ayodhya, Uttar Pradesh

Date: March 17

At his speech after a pooja, far-right Hindu monk Raju Das mocked Muslims and Christians, using slurs like “chaddar wale,” “malakish,” and “father.” He spread the ‘love jihad’ conspiracy, claiming Hindu girls fall into the trap and “cut themselves into pieces.” The fear mongered about Muslims, claiming, “There are 56 Muslim countries now, but this land once belonged to Hindus and had temples. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1709>

Location: Julum, Raipur, Chhattisgarh

Date: March 23

Bajrang Dal members staged a protest outside a Christian household, accusing the residents of converting into Christianity. They chanted slogans such as “Throw shoes at those who have converted” and referred to Christians as “more dangerous than cancer.” <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1806>

Location: Kota, Rajasthan

Date: March 30

At a Hindu New Year event, Amit Swamiji Maharaj spread the conspiracy of “love jihad.” He mocked the crucifixion of Jesus Christ and taunted Christians for worshipping him, directly targeting the Christian faith.

Date: March 30

During a protest rally organised by the BJP, members raised inflammatory slogans like “Jihadiyo ka naash ho,” “Christian missionary ka naash ho,” and “Jihadiyo ko panah dene walo ka naash ho.” The chants explicitly targeted Muslims and Christians with calls for their destruction. <https://t.me/hindutvawatchin/1863>

Location: Chaple, Raigarh, Chhattisgarh

Date: April 20

Hindu nationalists apprehended a group of Christians who were returning from their regular Sunday mass prayers, accusing them of engaging in religious conversion. They called the police, who recorded the group's statements and let them go.

Date: November 1

At the Virat Hindu Dharma Sabha, former BJP MLA and far-right leader T. Raja Singh delivered an incendiary speech calling for violence against alleged “love jihadis,” “cow killers,” and those involved in religious conversions. He urged the audience to join the Bajrang Dal “to kill love jihadis, cow killers and people who do religious conversions.” Singh said cowardly and “impotent” Hindus became Muslims and Christians.
